

APSPT-8 2013 Best Paper Award for Young Researcher

This year, in order to encourage outstanding young researchers in the fields of Plasma Science, APSPT-8 offers Best Paper Awards! The awards are to recognize excellence amongst the papers presented. All papers presented at the symposium, in either oral or poster sessions will be eligible for award selection. The presenting author should be younger than 35 years old (included). Please indicate the application in Abstract Submission System.

Selection Process

1. Nomination

A maximum of 10 papers in oral presentations and 15 papers in poster presentations are selected for nominees based on the submitted abstracts. Nominations are confidential.

2. Evaluation of nominated papers

The award committee members review the abstracts and attend the presentations of nominated papers during the symposium. The award committee meeting will be held during the symposium to check the final scores and select the winners.

3. Award ceremony

- Final awardees are announced at the closing ceremony of the symposium. They will receive a plaque.
